PRIORITIES

Motor Vehicle Crime

In April 1 Theft from Motor Vehicles and 3 Theft of Motor Vehicles took place.

We have seen a decrease in vehicle crime this month. We have had zero theft from motor vehicles, though one vehicle was attempted, but the catalytic converter had a protective box which prevented the converter from being taken.

We had three theft of motor vehicles. Look to add a tracking device to your vehicle particular for high valued vehicles. Speak to your manufactures. You can buy tracking devices such as air-tags which is a cheaper alternative, but remember to keep it out of sight.

A ghost immobiliser/system is also another idea. These apparently can protect your vehicle from key cloning/hacking through using a unique code. By uses the buttons in your vehicle such as those on the steering wheel, door panels or centre console, to allow you to make a unique, changeable, disarm sequence (like a PIN code). This must first be entered before you can drive your car. By doing this unless the suspect knows the code/sequence, the vehicle will not start.

Burglary

In April, 2 Residential and 0 Business & Community Burglaries took place.

Even if your at home, don't leave your property open for opportunistic thefts. Think like a burglar. Focus on entry points such as doors and windows, and think about ways to make them more secure. Look for areas where a burglar might be able to hide, such as behind large shrubs or trees near the home.

You maybe thinking of going away. Here are a few tips to keep your home and belongings stay safe while you're away:

- If you're off on holiday and wish to post anything on social media, make sure your posts aren't public and that they're only seen by your friends
- Leave lights and a radio on a timer to make the property appear occupied
- Get a trusted neighbour to keep an eye on your property or join a Neighbourhood or resident Watch Scheme
- Consider asking your neighbours to close curtains after dark and to park on your drive

King's Coronation

Witness Appeal

Detectives are appealing for witnesses to a stabbing at Sanderstead Station on Saturday 29th April just before 11pm. A 27-year-old man was allegedly stabbed in the back, but is in a stable condition and his injuries are not thought to be life-changing.

The British Transport Police are handling the investigation. Police and Paramedics attended the scene. The 27-year-old man was taken to hospital for treatment. No arrests have been made in connection at this time, and enquiries into the incident are ongoing. 
